Below is a list of hotels that are centrally located. The first two listed have given us some special rates. Most all the hotels here are fairly close together. All include free breakfast and Wi-Fi. Every chain from Hilton to Motel 6 is here, so take your pick.

- 1) The one most recommended: Hampton Inns & Suites – 3601 SW 38th Ave., Ocala, FL, 34474. Reservations have to be made by 3/30/2016 @ (352) 867-0300. Special rate for double with 2 queens is \$109.00 plus 10% Taxes per night. Use the code "Cal Farley" when you call. Regular rate is \$139.00
- 2) Country Inns & Suites (Carlson Property) – 3720 SW College Road, Ocala, FL, 34474. Reservations have to be made by 4/1/2016 @ (352) 237-0715. Special rate for double with 2 queens is \$108.00 plus 10% Taxes per night. Use "Cal Farley's Boys Ranch Alumni FL Gathering" as your code for special rate. Regular rate is \$144.00
- 3) Holiday Inns & Suites – 3600 SW 38th Ave., Ocala, FL, 34474, (352) 629-9500 (Very nice)
- 4) Courtyard Marriott – 3712 SW 38th Ave., Ocala, FL, (352) 237-8000 (\$107.00 - \$169.00)
- 5) Homewood Suites (Hilton) – 4610 SW 49th Rd., Ocala, FL, 34474 (352) 369-4610 (\$98.00 - \$159.00)
- 6) Hilton – 3600 SW 36th Ave., Ocala, FL, 34474, (352) 854-1400 (Vintage but nice) \$119.00 - \$209.00

Note: There is a Howard Johnson's that is nice that runs around \$49.00 - \$69.00 (Google it) and other privately owned properties that have lesser rates. Google "Hotels / Motels Ocala, FL. Lastly, my backyard has room for several tents... you are welcome!

If you are flying, the following airports are fairly close by and the distance from Ocala is as follows: Orlando International (MCO) - Around 1 Hr. 15 minutes. Sanford Florida International – Around 1 Hr. 15 minutes. Tampa International – Around 1 Hr. 30 minutes. Gainesville Florida International – Around 45 minutes. Allot of airports, but if you're shopping you might be surprised.

If you are driving, there really is only one way here... From everything West of Florida, you'll want to get on I-10 to I-75 South. You will come to the Ocala exits. Email me for additional directions, but the GPS will bring you right where you want to be...
