The Cal Farley's Boys Ranch Alumni Association is established to carry on the work that Cal & Mimi Farley began to current and former residents of Cal Farley's Boys Ranch and Girlstown. The Foundation is an endowment, from which only the proceeds may be used, and those, only to carry on the work of the Cal Farley's Boys Ranch Alumni Association. The primary missions of the Alumni Association for which the proceeds of the Foundation are used are, first, help former residents of Cal Farley's in times of crisis. These include those recent graduates who are primarily assisted by Cal Farley's, as well as all generations of former residents of Boys Ranch and Girlstown and their families. Secondly, the proceeds from the Foundation may be used to help provide educational assistance through the Cal Farley's Boys Ranch Alumni Association Scholarship program. These scholarships are made available primarily to the family members of former residents of Cal Farley's. Finally, the proceeds of the foundation are used to help Cal Farley's carry on the work of helping troubled children.

The Foundation Board of Directors administers the funds of the 501 (C) 3 non-profit corporation which is separate from the Cal Farley's Boys Ranch Alumni Association, but exists to help carry on the work of the Association. Benefactor Gift Commitments are payable to the CFBRAA Foundation and are tax-deductible. The Foundation Board of Directors is committed to being faithful stewards of all entrusted to them and to carrying on the good work begun by Cal Farley's and the CFBRAA.
